

Year 11 Literature Revision Timetable September 2016 – January 2017

From summer 2017, GCSEs in English Language and English Literature will be assessed entirely by examination. The content and level of challenge of these GCSEs has considerably increased from the demands of previous GCSEs. The qualification is untiered, which means that all students will sit the same papers, regardless of ability.

In particular, the course content for GCSE English Literature is considerably greater than in previous years:
